- Some gas lights call to mind a nostalgic Victorian, Gothic or Colonial era, while other contemporary styles are suitable for modern homes.
- Lamp materials include brass, copper or sand-cast aluminum.
- Lamp colors come in black, white, verdigris or bronze.
- Slide-out tempered glass is easy to clean.
- Gas lights can be mounted on posts for patio or front yard installations, or may be wall-mounted for entryways and garages.
- Electric lights cannot duplicate the same soft glow of gas lights.
- Likewise, gas lights do not create harsh shadows like electric lights.
- Optional wind guards keep flames steady.
- Gas lights remain on during power outage.
